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## EMPOWERMENT OF WOMEN IN OIL AND GAS AND HEALTH.

She has launched a health safety awareness campaign aimed at reducing the effects of oil and gas emissions on women's health.

For example, Atong Amos was a keynote speaker at the South Sudan Oil & Power Conference (SSOP) 2022, alongside other invited industry experts.

She spoke about how traditional oil and gas operations can pivot to next-generation energy solutions, driving change through difficult asset portfolio decisions, and emphasizing the importance of transparent and action-oriented leadership.

Greater gender equality and women's skill development, according to Atong Amos Juac, are in line with the growth and development of Africa's oil and gas industry, the UN's Sustainable Development Goals, and South Sudan's National Action Plan.

She oversaw and coordinated the organization's functions, which included M&E, Finance, Human Resources, and Programs. She was an outspoken supporter of gender equality and the empowerment of people with disabilities. UN WOMEN, AGRA, the Match International Women's Funds, Save the Children, UN FAO, UNICEF, CARE INTERNATIONAL, and the Canadian Embassy all provided funding.

As Country Director, she demonstrated her multitasking skills by doubling up as a Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of DA-Global Security Services Company Limited. As CEO she supervised strategic planning, made major corporate decisions, and offered leadership in financial management and operations. Her outstanding leadership made DA-Global Security Services competitive in the market and grew tremendously.

In 2018, She volunteered her efforts At South Sudan National Agenda Policy (SNAP) on girl-child marriage in South Sudan policy research.

Atong was involved in Research and Consultancy including participation as a Board Member of Ceasefire & Transitional Security Arrangements Monitoring and Verification Mechanism, Women Peace and Security Advisor at Nobel Women Initiative in Canada (2018-2019), Women Leadership and Access to Justice Charter (2017), among others.

The training she's accomplished includes Political Parties Constitutions and Bills, Sexual Violence in Conflict, Women's Rights and Advocacy (Feminist policy), Share-Fair Gender Training, Peace Building, Mediation, and Conflict Management, among others.

She continues to advocate for targeted actions to enhance the participation of women in the sector, such as providing scholarships to young women and empowering local female entrepreneurs.
